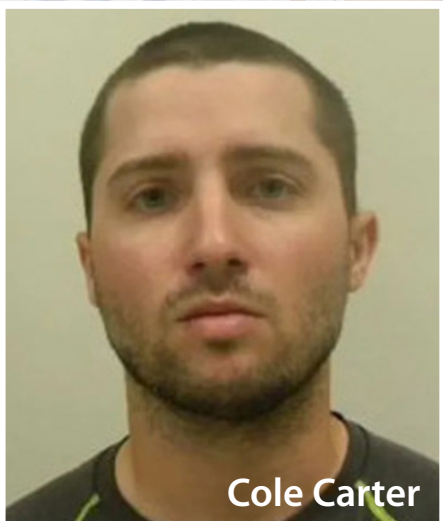

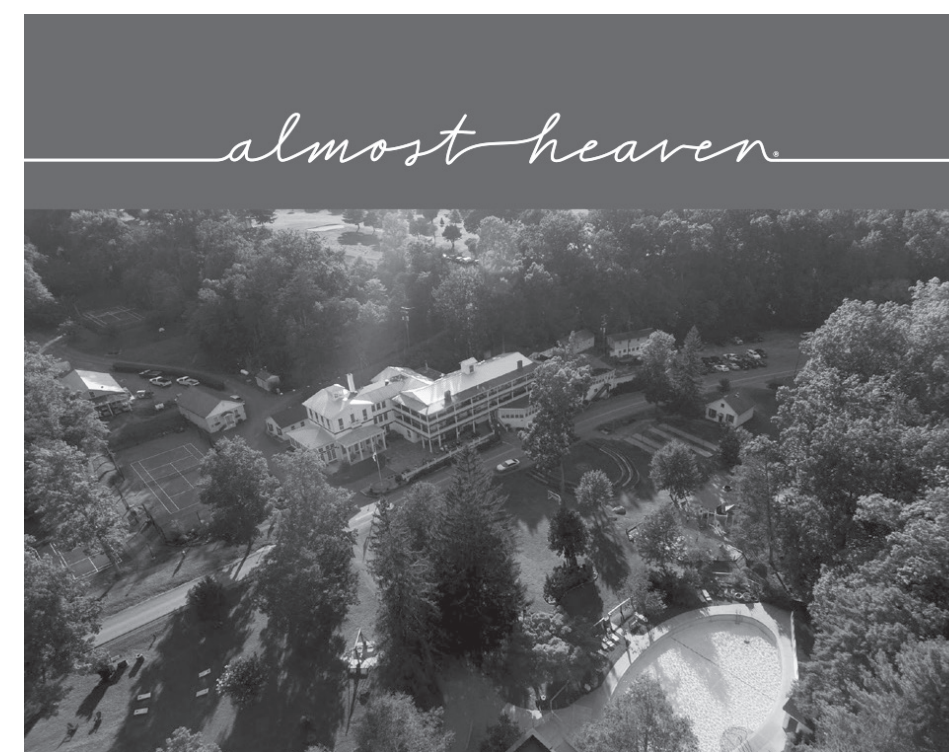

**Hurricane season**

**Join Fluvanna's 72 Hour Club**

The arrival of hurricane season is the perfect time to talk about getting – and staying – prepared for severe weather. While Central Virginia doesn't typically feel the full force of these storms at their strongest, it's still important to know the potential for severe weather brought by hurricanes.

Hurricanes are massive storm systems that form over warm ocean waters and move toward land. The Atlantic hurricane season runs from June 1 to Nov. 30. Potential threats from hurricanes include powerful winds, heavy rainfall, storm surges, coastal and inland flooding, rip currents, tornadoes and landslides.

Hurricanes can happen along any U.S. coast or in any territory in the Atlantic or Pacific Oceans, and can affect areas more than 100 miles inland. Hurricanes are most active in September.

If hurricane warnings have been issued, find safe shelter right away.

- Protect yourself and loved ones: Evacuate if told to do so, and take refuge in a designated storm shelter or an interior room.
- Listen for emergency information and alerts.
- Only use generators outdoors and away from windows.
- Turn around; don't drown. Do not walk, swim or drive through flood waters.
- Don't wait for the storm. Be prepared by taking the steps listed below.

Know your area's risk of severe weather. Hurricane season begins soon, but severe weather can happen any time of the year.

Listen and watch for emergency alerts and Information. Sign up for Fluvanna County's emergency alert system: Go to [www.fluvannacounty.org](http://www.fluvannacounty.org) and click on the alerts sign up button at the bottom of the page. The emergency alert system and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration weather radio also provide emergency alerts. If you live in an area at risk for flash flooding, watch for warning signs such as heavy rain.

Practice. Know where to go for safe shelter from high winds. Small interior rooms, rooms on the lowest level not prone to flooding, or a ready-made emergency safe shelter are best. Make plans for evacuation or sheltering in place. Become familiar with the county's shelter locations.

Gather supplies for at least three days. Keep in mind each person's specific needs,

including medication. Don't forget the needs of pets.

Keep important documents in a safe place or create password-protected digital copies.

Protect your property. Declutter drains and gutters. Install check valves in plumbing to prevent backups. Review insurance policies.

Join Fluvanna County's 72 Hour Club. After an emergency, it is vital that every household be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours. Emergency services and responders will be busy and often overwhelmed. Representatives from FEMA will take time to arrive and set up to help. A prepared community is a resilient community and will recover faster.

Your 72 Hour kit should contain:

- Water: a minimum of one gallon per person, per day;
- Medication: for people and pets, refilled before the storm arrives (pharmacies could be down for days);
- Flashlights; glow sticks for children;
- Battery, solar or hand-cranked radio; extra batteries;
- Waterproof lighter or matches;
- Can openers; knife;
- Children and infants: diapers, formula, coloring books and games;
- Cell phones: Keep them on chargers. If the power goes out you will still have a form of contact;
- At least three days' worth of nonperishable foods, such as crackers, peanut butter, trail mix, dried fruit and canned meats;
- Pets: Stock up on food and water. Have pets microchipped or keep collars with tags on at all times. If you are separated from your pet, microchips and collars will make the reunion much easier and quicker; and
- Water for livestock.

Whenever severe weather is forecast, Fluvanna County emergency management is monitoring the situation. Alerts can be sent from the county's emergency alert system to every resident in Fluvanna who may be in harm's way. But we can only alert you if you sign up. Visit [fluvannacounty.org](http://fluvannacounty.org) and click on the alerts sign up icon at the bottom of the home page.

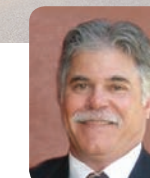

# Fluco baseball wins Region championships

The Flying Fluco baseball team won the Region 3C championships Thursday (May 30) after trouncing the Brookville Bees 8-1. The game was played at Liberty Bedford High, a neutral field, and the Flucos scored three in the first inning and three in the third to rout the number three-seeded Brookville Bees.

As a result of the win, the Flucos advanced to the State quarterfinals, hosting Abingdon High on Tuesday (June 4).

"The three runs in the first [inning] were huge," said Fluco Coach Joel Gray after the game. In the first, senior third baseman Ryan Groome led off with a solid single. Andrew Ward singled down the right field line, sending Groome to third. On a steal attempt, the throw bounced into center field, resulting in one run in and a runner at third. Senior catcher Jacob Critzer walked and a steal of second set up junior shortstop Cameron Shields. He singled to score two runs and the Flucos were in control.

After scoring one in the second inning, the Flucos took complete control in the third. Critzer singled, Shields singled and Mason Gross singled to load the bases with one out. After a force out at the plate, junior outfielder Toby Sherman launched a long double to the fence, scoring three. Leading off the fifth, Shields doubled for his third hit of the game. He moved to third on a wild pitch and came home on a ground out for the Flucos' final run.

The Flucos used three pitchers to contain the Bees. Andrew Ward pitched the first four innings and allowed three hits, striking out three and walking none. He allowed no runs. With a comfortable lead, Gray brought in junior side-arm throwing lefty Kristian Negrón to pitch the fifth and sixth. Negrón allowed only one unearned run. Right-handed junior Walt Dansey pitched the seventh and allowed no hits.

After the game, Gray noted that he hopes his team's "bats are catching fire at the right time." The Flucos recorded 12 hits in six innings against the Bees. Shields and Groome both had three hits, while Critzer had two singles, a walk and a hit by pitch. In addition to his big double, Sherman also had a single.

## May 28 semifinals

The Flucos qualified for the Region 3C final by winning their May 28 game against the number four-seeded Broadway Gobblers. They definitely did not coast to victory. The Gobblers managed to score three in the second inning and one in the third. Going into the bottom of the sixth, in a seven-inning game, the Flucos trailed 1-4. Their only run came in the fourth when Critzer and Kevin Ward slugged back-to-back doubles.

It looked like the Flucos were in trouble – but an incredible rally turned the game completely around.

Andrew Ward led off the sixth with a long home run to right. A hard hit out followed. The Gobblers needed five outs to go to the final. The Flucos sent 13 more batters to the plate before the Gobblers got the two outs they needed to end the sixth inning.

After Andrew Ward's home run and the hard ground out, the Broadway manager took out his starter and brought in a lefty to face left hitting Kevin Ward, who had two hits off the starting pitcher. This typical move did not work. Ward walked, as did Shields, to put the tying run on base. Gross singled to score a run. Sherman singled to score another run. Kyle Algieri singled to score the go ahead run. A.J. Brown grounded to short, but the attempt to get a force out at second failed. Groome singled to score two and the Flucos led 7-4. After a couple more walks, Shields also singled for

two runs. The Fluco totals for the bottom of the sixth were 15 batters, 10 runs, six hits, four walks, a hit batter and an error by Broadway. The Flucos ended up winning by an apparently comfortable 11-4 score, but it looked pretty grim for most of the game.

The Flucos started against the Gobblers with Kevin Ward on the mound. He had trouble only in the third when four straight singles and a fielder's choice brought home three runs. A fourth run scored in the third when a single to center took a fluke bounce over the fielder's head for a lead-off triple.

Gray brought in Andrew Ward to pitch in the sixth and he struck out four and walked one over the last two innings for the win.

As a result, Andrew Ward was the winning pitcher for the Flucos in all three Region play-off games. He started the play-off with an astonishing no-hitter in which he struck out 21.

In competing for the State title, the Flucos are going up against all the Class 3 schools in the state. The Virginia High School League divides all the public high schools in Virginia into six classes, based on enrollment size. As a result, there are six State champions, one in each class. Class 3 could be described as the smaller medium-sized schools. In each class, there are four Regions: A, B, C and D. The State tournament includes the top two teams from each Region.

# Summer fun in full swing

Teens and young adults are itching to get out of the house to savor sunlight and the older community can finally spend time outdoors instead of cooped up from cold weather.

Luckily, Fluvanna County Parks and Recreation (FCPR), Lake Monticello Owners' Association, the library and more are prepped and ready to go for the summer season with activities for community members to enjoy.

First and foremost the Lake Monticello pool season started May 25. The pool is open daily from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. Not to mention the beaches surrounding the lake are opened all year long, so do not forget to grab your chairs and floats to unwind on beach and relax in the water.

Nicole Hackenberg and staff, which includes former and current Fluvanna County High School All-District and All-State players as well as Division I, II and III college players, will host volleyball camps for beginners and intermediates in June at the Carysbrook Gym. Youth basketball camp with a non-competitive environment will begin in July for kids ages 5-12. Camp Friendship will host tennis camp for ages 8-16 for all skill levels from June through August and finally, the Equus Springs Farm will share a love for horses through riding lessons, horse care, feeding and much more with day camp starting in July.

The fun does not stop there. The Empowered Players of Fluvanna is offering a free summer program for kids and teens to join them at the Carysbrook Performing Arts Center. The Young Empowered Players camp (ages 5-13) will

work on the performances of The Jungle Book starting June 17. Then Improv-A-Thon (ages 8-14), Direct 4U (Grades 9+), and the Summer Show Spectacular (ages 14+) will take place in July.

Be sure to check out the county library for summer fun each day. Mondays at 2 p.m. the library will show movies June 3 through Aug. 5. On Tuesdays the Master Naturalists and Master Gardeners join together to teach those who are curious about nature about subjects ranging from the solar system to survival skills to plants in space. For those not quite kids and not quite young adults, Fluvanna welcomes all tweens age 12-15 to gather at the Lake Monticello Clubhouse for game nights with pizza and popcorn on June 15 and July 13 from 7-10 p.m. Board games like Catan, Monopoly and Risk are just some of the games tweens can play to compete with their friends. Do not miss out on the door prizes and raffle.

As for adult activities, ages 18-plus can relax on a leisurely float down the Rivanna River while Brian Coffield, local historian and boatman, guides them along the Rivanna River History Float. On the last Sunday of each month, participants will stop and visit historic sites and structures that were once an integral part of commercial navigation on the Rivanna in the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries.

Continuing the water theme, on Aug. 3 eight participants can learn the basics of kayaking, paddling and safety afloat with an intro to kayaking class. The class will be held in the evening from 6-8:30 p.m. and meet at Beach 4 in Lake Monticello.

In addition to nature activities, explore Pleasant Grove with the Virginia Master Naturalists. They'll lead monthly hikes on the second Saturday of each month. If solo hiking is more your style, follow one of the 23 trails at Pleasant Grove covering over 20 miles. Remember to share the trail with horses, bikers and hikers.

On a hot summer day consider floating down the James River with Reeling Rafting. This four-mile float lets you sit back and relax while the water does the work. You can also bring a cooler to float along beside you, so pack extra water and snacks for the potential two-

to four-hour float.

Scottsville also has its 34<sup>th</sup> annual James River Batteau Festival June 19 from 4-8 p.m. In 1985 historians and enthusiasts decided to keep the memory alive of the flat wooden cargo vessels that travel from Lynchburg to Maiden's Landing in Powhatan. The event will have music and food while onlookers watching the batteaux arrive at Scottsville's Landing.

And don't forget about Lake Monticello's Fourth of July celebration held at the Main Beach and pool area. In previous years there was a 5K Spirit Run, a sand sculpture contests, horseshoe tournament, pool games, the lake swim and a boat parade. Celebrate the country's independence with your friends and neighbors. At dusk, people gather on the water, at the marina, and on the beach to watch the fireworks show.

Are you upset that you missed the carnival in early May at Pleasant Grove? Don't be. Fluvanna County's Sixth annual county fair Aug. 14-17 will host similar carnival rides, live music, food

vendors and much more.

And if you are ever in Charlottesville, have an adventure by exploring the night sky at the McCormick Observatory. It is open on the first and third Friday nights of every month from 9-11 p.m. During the day enjoy Charlottesville's four spray grounds located at Forrest Hills Park, Greenleaf Park, Belmont Park and Tonsler Park.

If the heat is too much, stay indoors and head to Regal Stonefield and IMAX in Charlottesville. The theater is participating in the 2019 Regal Summer Movie Express from June to September, in which kids' movie tickets are reduced to \$1.

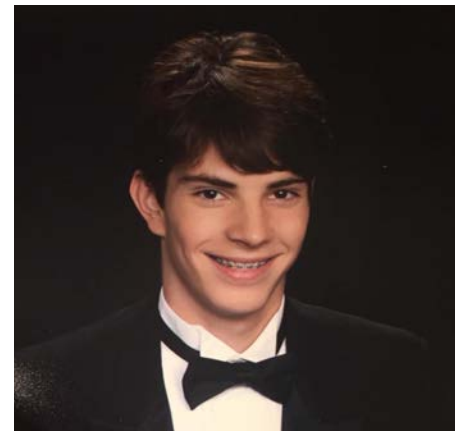
#### What are your best school memories?
