



PUBLIC HEARING

Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors

Wednesday, September 16, 2020, at 7:00 pm

Pursuant to Virginia Code Section 15.2-2204, a public hearing will be held at the Fluvanna County Library in Palmyra, Virginia for citizens of the County to have the opportunity to be heard by the Board of Supervisors for the following item:

SUP 20:01 Central Virginia Electric Cooperative – A request for a special use permit to construct an electrical substation (major utility) on 4 acres known as Tax Map 39, Section A, Parcel 34A. The property is located on the south side of West River Road (Route 6), approximately 0.5 miles west of the intersection with Rolling Road South (State Route 620). The parcel is zoned A-1 Agricultural, General and located within the Rural Preservation Planning Area and the Fork Union Election District.

The public is invited to attend the hearing at which persons affected may appear and present their views. If the September 16, 2020 meeting of the Board of Supervisors is held “virtually”, as has been practice of the County in recent months due to the COVID-19 pandemic, instructions for participation in the public hearing will be available on the County’s website: <https://www.fluvannacounty.org/>.
