Silk City Printing to relocate to county creating 93 new jobs

The company will invest \$5.7 million to establish a new silkscreened apparel production operation in the former Thomasville facility that has been vacant since 2007. Virginia successfully competed with New Jersey for the project, which will create 93 new jobs.

"We are honored that Silk City Printing has chosen Fluvanna County and Virginia as its new home," said Northam. "This important project will create 93 valuable jobs for a rural community while also transforming a long-vacant facility into a state-of-theart production operation. Stimulating

growth across diverse business sectors will help advance our economic recovery, and we thank Silk City Printing for this investment in the Commonwealth and our people."

Silk City Printing, LLC was established in 2017 and produces branded, silkscreened apparel for retail outlets including Target and Walmart. The company has an additional facility located in New Jersey.

"What a great addition to the Fluvanna County business community," said chairman of the Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors John "Mike" Sheridan. "Bringing nearly 100 jobs to Fluvanna will provide a great opportunity for our residents to live and work here.

Vote yes on constitutional redistricting amendment

In this year's election Virginians have a historic opportunity to end gerrymandering, a practice that has been in place since Gov. Patrick Henry drew up a district to try to keep James Madison, father of the Constitution that Henry opposed, out of the House of Representatives. The party in power of the General Assembly can set the boundaries of congressional districts after each decennial census. Our 5th congressional district is the poster child of gerrymandering. It stretches vertically from the Virginia-North Carolina Border for 250 miles up to Fauquier County in Northern Virginia. The 5th congressional district is Virginia's largest, larger in area than six US states. The boundaries make no sense whatsoever except to the politicians who constructed it to lock in their power.

The proposed amendment on this year's ballot spells out a process for developing new state and congressional maps, beginning with the 2021 redistricting. According to the proposed amendment, "Each electoral district will be composed of contiguous and compact territory to give, as nearly as practicable, representation in

proportion to the population of the district." A 16-member panel of eight legislators and eight citizens, evenly divided between Democrats and Republicans, will be tasked with developing the maps. Is this a perfect solution? Probably not, but the fact that both Republicans and Democrats are criticizing it with equal vigor gives us reason to believe that this is the best solution our political process could come up with. I urge you to vote yes for the proposed constitutional amendment.



We are Freedom Fighters

In 1956, Nikita Khrushchev said, "We will take America without firing a shot. We do not have to invade the U.S. We will destroy you from within..." Something else happened in 1956; a group of Freedom Fighters in Hungary rose up against their Soviet occupiers. They took up arms against the authoritarian terror perpetrated against the Hungarian people by the Soviet Union. I know a lot about this because my father was one of those Freedom Fighters. He refused to join the Soviet Communist Party and instead chose to stand up to a murderous totalitarian state. The revolt was crushed and my father, after managing to outsmart the secret police, crawled across minefields to freedom.

My father made it to the USA and lived the American dream. He is not alive today to see the USA fall under the thrall of Putin, to watch GRU propaganda laundered in the USA for political gain, to see Americans cavalierly call their opponents "communists" when they themselves are in bed with an oppressive, totalitarian state that trades in lies, corruption and political terrorism.

Pandemic means leadership program to 'Zoom in' on Fluvanna

PRESS RELEASE

The Fluvanna Leadership Development Program will "zoom in" on the county beginning Jan. 7 with at least the first classes being virtual via Zoom, due to the pandemic and the hope that the coronavirus situation will allow some later classes to be more in-person. The group is beginning to sign up a limited number of students for this year's classes.

Due to Zoom limitations, classes

"This will be a year like no other, but we like to think it will be better in many ways, despite COVID," said FLDP co-Chair Rudy Garcia. "For example, students will be able to avoid long drives at night to some of the class locations. And the fact that the Zoom classes will be recorded will give classmates flexibility in when they attend classes."

also will be shorter and more frequent.

The FLDP has traditionally held its 16 biweekly classes in a variety of locations throughout the county as part of the process of familiarizing classmates with more areas of the county. The classes also have given classmates the chance to meet in person, talk with and ask questions of county leaders, such as county supervisors, the county administrator, the county schools superintendent, leaders of Lake Monticello, leading businesspeople, non-profits and others important to county life.

"Obviously, the in-person part of this is something we have to give up - at least at first - due to the pandemic," said co-Chair Mike Feazel. "It's great to be able to meet face-to-face with officials, shake their hands and talk with them, as FLDP always provided. We wrestled with that, but safety and health just have to come first. We still kind of hope the health situation will improve enough for some in-person options. And our classes will be as totally interactive as ever, with classmates able to grill county leaders about anything, and get answers."

"Regardless, we believe this is a unique opportunity for Fluvanna residents to learn about their county and the people who run it," said FLDP Treasurer Jackie Bland. "And some of the advantages of this new way of conducting classes we hope will offset some of the disadvantages. In fact, some of the new concepts are so good that we may continue using them even after the pandemic is over."

FLDP graduates have gone on to leadership positions throughout Fluvanna County - including a majority of members of the county board of supervisors and of the county school board, seats on virtually every county government commission and committee, three of the seven seats on the Lake Monticello Owners Association board, and as participants in virtually every significant service and organization non-profit throughout the county. At last count, members of the 17 classes that graduated from FLDP have held more than 300 positions in Fluvanna.

Others take the class just to feel more at home in the county, and to know who to go to if they need help solving a problem.

Due to the coronavirus, FLDP decided to limit this year's class to 25 persons, so it's recommended that those who are interested sign up early. Also, because some FLDP activities will be limited, the fee for this year's class will be only \$25, instead of \$50.

Fluvanna women form network

Being new to Virginia and the area, businesswoman Jan Tatangelo saw something missing. Originally a business owner in California, she left for the peace and tranquility of rural Virginia but being as outgoing and pro-active as she is, the something that was missing was still nagging her. She noticed there was no supportive network for women in business and decided to set out and make it happen with the help of other local women.

"I saw the need to bring women business owners together to network and support each other's success and personal growth." She lit up with the idea of starting a WIB (Women in Businesses) group in Fluvanna. "I've had great experiences being involved in WIB groups for fundraising and networking over my career and thought it would be an exciting new project."

Women account for 45 percent of small business owners, most of them in hair and nail salons, beauty products, or domestic cleaning services. More women are successful entrepreneurs in states like North Carolina or Georgia than in California. The gender gap is one reason for the disparity, and they are less likely to run businesses such as restaurants or building maintenance. It is also difficult for women to get the support they need compared to their male counterparts.

Their goals are to promote shopping local for services that keep people working and increase the tax base and economy.

"The entrepreneurial desire continues to grow with women starting more businesses than ever, especially home-based businesses so they can have an opportunity to stay home with the family while giving support," she said. "The network is designed to mentor and build confidence in these new business owners. It also naturally builds leadership skills in our

members. Learning from each other is vital to our community. Women are changing the landscape of business and at the forefront of business leadership."

Tatangelo believes the future of the network is strong because of the needs and desire to grow.

"We're a Facebook centered group with 108 members, with no dues. We love co-op marketing opportunities and meet for lunch once a month and are introducing a monthly Zoom call to promote our members." Tatangelo's energy is limitless and her excitement shows when speaking about the future of women in business. But there is still a lot of road to travel and obstacles to deal with but women in Fluvanna are making inroads owning businesses in real estate, tax preparation and accounting, and insurance. Many women own and operate dog grooming businesses and Karen Dernbach has owned Happy Tails for many years which has been a very successful business.

Peggy Shanklin, who owned one of those domestic cleaning businesses is currently in real estate and works closely with Tatangelo on WIB.

"It is about supporting local women-owned business and bringing women together to support each other with ideas, referrals, and education," said Shanklin. "And lifting each other, forming long-lasting relationships and helping each other succeed in a male-dominated world of business. It is about growing, bringing in new members and to diversify our membership to bring the best Fluvanna has to offer together."

One of WIB's goals is to have a women's expo in the spring and a fundraiser for local women going into nursing who need items as stethoscopes, medical bags, and other necessary items.

"We have strength in numbers to accomplish big goals," said Tatangelo. They're also planning on wine, women, and business events for networking, perhaps adding art to those events as well to support the local art

"We're open to any local women in business or to those who love women in business. We do not exclude men since we like them too," said Tatangelo, smilina.





Supervisors vote to postpone penalties and interest on property tax

The Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors unanimously approved a temporary ordinance change at their regular meeting on Wednesday (Oct. 21) that will postpone penalties and interest on second-half property tax payments.

Under the change, second-half bills are still due on Dec. 5 but penalties on late payments won't be applied until Dec 30. W.ith many residents struggling financially due to the pandemic, the temporary change gives them a little breathing room to make payments without added late fees.

Broadband

Efforts to expand high-speed internet to underserved parts of the county received an unexpected boost as Lovingston-based Nelson Cable said it could bring fiber to parts of Fluvanna.

Nelson Cable has access to power lines operated by Appalachian Electric Power (AEP), which serves a small number of Fluvanna customers near Scottsville. Using these lines, Nelson Cable said it could bring service to 45 homes along Poplar Spring Road.

Fluvanna will pay \$60,000 out of

Federal CARES Act funding for Nelson Cable to run the lines and the house drops. Customers would then pay between \$9.99 and \$78.99 per month for service, depending on speed. Parents with school-aged children could qualify for that \$9.99 per month rate.

Supervisors passed the motion on a vote of 5-0.

EMS billing

The Board approved a contract with ImageTrend to manage billing for the county's EMS services.

Purchasing Officer Cyndi Toler said the new contract would result in significant savings. The current provider charges 4.75 percent on net billings, while ImageTrend will take 4.50 percent. Additionally, ImageTrend would waive a \$20,500 annual fee the county currently pays for call reporting software used by fire & rescue.

School supplemental

Supervisors also voted 5-0 to accept two supplemental appropriations for Fluvanna County Public Schools (FCPS). The schools will receive \$95,296 in federal grant funding and

\$596,190 in coronavirus relief funds to help with COVID related expenses.

Brenda Gilliam, executive director for instruction and finance for FCPS said these funds could be used for replacement Chromebooks and other technology related to online learning, while \$300,000 will go to three 2018 model school buses.

Mutual aid

County Administrator Eric Dahl requested the authorization of an advertisement for a public hearing on a mutual aid agreement between Fluvanna County, the Fork Union Sanitary District, and the Louisa County Water Authority. Under the agreement, if either county needed support to keep water and wastewater systems operating during some emergency or worst-case scenario, they could request temporary staffing, subject to later reimbursement.

The public hearing will be held Nov 18.
