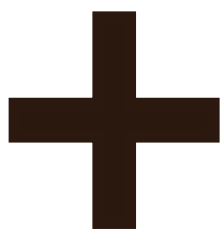

Project finished on-time and on-budget Rts. 53-618 Roundabout Complete

Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Rt. 53 (Thomas Jefferson Parkway) and Rt. 618 (Lake Monticello Road) in Fluvanna County finished on-time Nov. 17.

Under a \$2.2 million construction contract, Chemung Contracting Corp. of Mitchells replaced the "T" intersection with a single-lane roundabout.

The roundabout will improve safety

and more efficiently move traffic through the intersection. According to 2019 traffic data, approximately 7,700 vehicles use Rt. 53 daily. The traffic count on Rt. 618 is 3,100 vehicles per day.

Something new for Palmyra's rail trail

For almost 70 years the Virginia Air Line Railroad (VAL) was a much-loved fixture in Fluvanna County. Since 1908, in a time when many people did not own cars, VAL provided a real service transporting people as well as freight. The VAL spanned

a 30 mile stretch of rail connecting the C & O Railroad's James River Line near Bremono Bluff to its Main Line at Lindsay. However, times change and by the post war 1950s former rail passengers preferred the flexibility and pleasure of driving their own cars. Trucking over improved highways eventually replaced rail freight. By the 1970s the railroad could no longer compete with changing attitudes. The VAL was discontinued, and the tracks completely removed by 1978. James F. Perrin, who represented the Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors, declared the loss of the VAL "a great tragedy for Fluvanna County."

In 2004, 25 years later, the old VAL rail bed gained a new life as a walking trail. Another 15 years passed when the Fluvanna Board of Supervisors tasked the volunteer Palmyra Area Revitalization Committee (PARC), a group that emerged from an FLDP project, with encouraging improvements in the village of Palmyra.

The committee endeavored to complete several village projects, one of which was developing a nature guide for the rail trail. The new guide would

include items of nature along the half-mile trail as well as some rail line history. PARC requested assistance from the Rivanna Master Naturalists who could readily identify the nature. Regarding rail line history PARC approached the Chesapeake & Ohio Historical Society in Clifton Forge which provided interesting historical information about the VAL.

Walking this intriguing trail, which offers different views in each season, one can imagine the hefty Bulldog trains carrying oversized freight along the tracks. Visible remnants of railroad construction remain. Large earthen bowls had been dug out by immigrant laborers in inhospitable weather conditions to provide the dirt needed to level the bed for the tracks. There are two sections where topography, strewn with boulders, rise on each side of the rail bed indicating where blasting may have been necessary to clear the way. Looking down the embankments one can see and hear the Rivanna River bending its way southward. It draws one to imagine the engineering required more than a century ago to build the

rail line alongside a cliff.

Nature has provided numerous trees, ferns and other vegetation along the old rail bed. The deep earthen bowls once dug out are now home to many trees. One of these deep bowls, bucolically beautiful, houses a lovely stream. Old railroad ties, left along the rail bed serve as a reminder of what was once here, the much-loved Virginia Air Line in Palmyra.

The development of the nature trail guide and the installation of coordinating sign posts along the trail were accomplished by the work of several dedicated PARC volunteers: Aaron Spitzer, Director of Parks & Recreation, Jan Pavlacka, Walter Hussey, Jackie Bland and Kornel & Kris Krechoweckyj.

The nature trail can be accessed at the Main Street parking lot in the village of Palmyra across from the courthouse complex. An illustrated nature trail guide is available at the entrance to the trail.

Fluvanna's COVID transmission rate considered moderate

Dr. Denise Bonds, health director of the Thomas Jefferson Health District (TJHD) told the Board of Supervisors Wednesday (Nov. 18) that Fluvanna County has seen 446 confirmed cases of COVID-19, 44 hospitalizations, and nine fatalities since the start of the pandemic this spring.

TJDH has pursued an aggressive testing effort across the five-county district, conducting nearly 120,000 tests since April. District-wide, the department and their partners have identified 4,885 cases and seen 80 fatalities.

Fluvanna currently has a case rate of 6.4 per 100,000, which is considered a moderate rate of community transmission. The daily positivity rate -- the number of tests which come back positive -- is 4.4 percent within the county. This is higher than the district-wide positivity rate of 2.1 percent, but still considered low.

While Fluvanna and the rest of the district have done well at keeping the spread of the virus limited compared to other health districts, she cautioned that cases are now on the rise statewide.

She urged residents to think carefully about their holiday plans.

"If you are going to celebrate Thanksgiving with a group of individuals outside your immediate household, you really need to take care that you don't bring an unwanted guest.... and that would be COVID," she said.

If you do plan to travel, she recommended quarantining or getting tested before you go and to practice safe distancing when you arrive -- including eating your holiday meal outside if possible, and wearing your mask unless you are eating.

Prescribed burn at Pleasant Grove

Parks and Recreation asked for permission to begin the process of conducting a controlled burn at Pleasant Grove later this winter.

Director Aaron Spitzer and Parks and Rec Advisory Board member Walter Hussey said this was the necessary next step in the Wildlife Meadows program.

Hussey said the program, first approved in 2014, has been a great success. He noted that every Fluvanna school child in the past five years has either planted trees or wildflower seeds during annual Earth Day celebrations, and the area has become

popular with local birders, hikers, and other visitors.

Maintaining the meadow is labor-intensive for both staff and volunteers, who manually remove invasive species and vegetation and cut down non-native trees by hand. A prescribed burn program would mimic the natural process for creating healthy meadowlands, while reducing labor.

They are specifically looking at a 10-acre area between Fluvanna County High School and the main road into the park, along with a four-acre patch near the soccer field.

The burn would be conducted by experts from the state's Department of Forestry in the late winter, when grass is dormant and nesting wildlife is limited. The costs are estimated at \$1,000 to \$1,500 and would come from funds already in the Parks and Rec budget.

The Board's approval is the start of a longer process of getting permits and waivers, coordinating with local agencies, and educating the public.

"It'll just be black for two month," Spitzer assured the supervisors. Healthy green grass will sprout up again in the spring.

The motion passed 5-0.

In other business:

Supervisor also unanimously approved several requests, including:

- The annual deer cull at Pleasant Grove by the Wheelin Sportsmen on New Years' Day.
- An \$18,153 expenditure from CARES Act funds for a new power cot for Ambulance 49.
- Acceptance of \$500,000 in discretionary grant funds for the establishment of an Adult Drug Court and Veterans Treatment Court

Celebrating Thanksgiving during a pandemic

Traditions have changed to ensure health and safety for loved ones during the COVID-19 pandemic. The tradition of celebrating Thanksgiving is one of them.

FAA goes online with annual fall show

Normally at this time of the year there would be judging, ribbons, a reception, recognition of the artist's work, congratulations, and a few sales. But this year, the coronavirus put a damper on the annual Fluvanna Art Association fall show.

In 2019, the former People's Choice was done away with and replaced with an exhibit, that few artists par-

ticipated in and that drew low attendance at the reception. The plan for this year was to have a judged show in the spring and fall but neither happened because of the coronavirus.

It was suggested that an online show would be a replacement since other art groups were doing the same and some in combination with live exhibits. But since the FAA members

were against gathering for any event even if controlled, the option was to try an online show with a theme.

This year's theme was a Tribute to Troy Weidenheimer. Artist, member, and mentor, Weidenheimer died in 2019 but left a legacy that inspired all the artists he taught. Weidenheimer was known for his landscapes, seascapes, figures, portraits,

flowers, and trees and for embracing the natural world and its realism.

Webmaster and artist Todd Mathes was instrumental in putting the show together online. Mathes had two pieces in the show and the "Butterfly Feeder," made out of concrete, a huge leaf with colors of pinks, purples, blues, and greens, would make a beautiful statement in any garden.

All showed exceptional skill and style. One of the original members of the FAA since 1975, Windy Payne, is stronger yet soft and light with her touch and colors in her landscapes. A realist in some aspects of her acrylic paintings, she adds touches of lavender and blue to natural neutral areas like rocks and weeds giving it a pop of gentle color. Barbara Ryan is similar in her approach but uses eye-popping colors instead of the softer tones and pastels that Payne chooses. Ryan emulates Vincent van Gogh with her bright, colorful brush

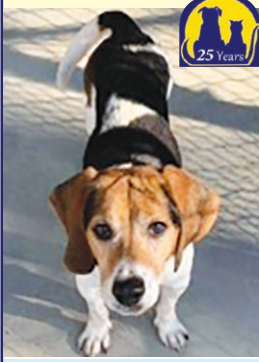

strokes in "Let's Stay Here Awhile."

Joanne Braniff's "Wish For A Fish Pond" is a classic landscape in oil, skillfully executed in the traditional style. It speaks of a quiet natural beauty. Janet Rugari follows the same traditional path with her still life "Wildflowers" in oil.

For the artists who have progressed to the next level, Linda Napier's "Adirondack Pond," shows her attention to detail and skillfully blended muted colors and strong contrast. Ande Kirchenheiter's "The Big Wave," has an easy flow and the complementary colors add drama to the piece.

"Autumn Wall" surprise viewers with her yellow rose in pen and ink and watercolor. She put herself in the novice category and it was clear her expertly rendered rose should have

been in the intermediate category. Artists choose the category they put themselves in based on their experience.

Mary Ann Friedman's work always shows her signature style. Her impressionistic watercolor flowers fill the framed area up-close and without painstaking detail. It is her skill at color blending that makes her pieces stand-out.

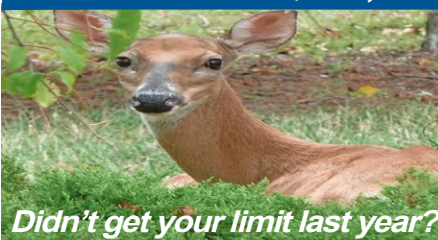

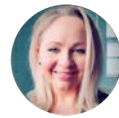
