Injured Laker recognized for bravery in deck collapse

Nearly a month after a deck collapsed seriously injuring Laker Derrell Alexander and two others, Alexander was recognized by Lake Monticello Volunteer Fire & Rescue for his heroic actions, which were credited with saving a child.

Alexander, another adult and a child were injured June 26 when a deck collapsed at 443 Jefferson Drive. Alexander was injured badly enough with multiple injuries, to require transportation by Pegasus to the University of Virginia Medical Center and the others were transported to U.Va. by the rescue squad, Lake Monticello Fire & Rescue officials reported at the time.

The deck was about 10 feet by 12 feet and located 15 feet off the ground, said Lake Monticello Fire Chief Richie Constantino, adding that the collapse caused some rescue difficulties, which were "quickly overcome by our members who

assessed the gravity and severity of the incident and injuries."

At the award presentation last night, Constantino praised Alexander's quick actions.

The deck was about 10 feet by 12 feet and located 15 feet off the ground, said Lake Monticello Fire Chief Richie Constantino, adding that the collapse caused some rescue difficulties, which were "quickly overcome by our members who assessed the gravity and severity of the incident and injuries."

At the award presentation last night, Constantino praised Alexander's quick actions. Witness's statements indicated that the victims were standing on the deck at the time of the collapse just after 8 p.m., when, without warning, the deck began to fall to the ground, according to the Civilian Award Citation written by the Fire Chief. "Derrell Alexander instinctively

grabbed the child and shielded her from harm using his own body for protection and 'rode' the deck down to ground, where it flipped over trapping the victims underneath," the citation reads.

"The actions of Derrell Alexander were quick, selfless and truly heroic. His successful efforts saved the toddler from danger, serious physical injury and possible death, which involved exceptional courage and bravery. As Chief of the Lake Monticello Fire Department, I am both proud and honored to recommend Derrell Alexander for a civilian award."

"Today I accepted the Civilian Award from Lake Monticello Volunteer Fire & Rescue," Alexander posted on his Facebook Page. "I want to thank this crew from the bottom of my heart, my family and last but not least, Charles Ford and Destani Archer. They all kept me alive that day. I am forever thankful. Just to be able to walk is a blessing...Next week I start physical therapy and I'm going to push myself to get back to where I was."

Chief Constantino also praised his team. "The speed, coordination and professionalism of both fire and rescue personnel allowed for the rapid triage, treatment and transportation, by air and ground, of those with significant injuries," Constantino said, and that "allowed for their rapid patient care and overall positive outcomes."

"Welcome to the fire"

School board deals with masks, transgender issues, critical race theory

Fluvanna welcomed its newest superintendent with a rousing chorus of "No masks. No Critical Race Theory. No change to our policies for transgender students."

Only the mask issue was settled at the Fluvanna School Board meeting Wednesday (July 21).

The Board voted 4-1 to make masks voluntary at school when it opens Aug. 11. James Kelley (Palmyra) cast the dissenting vote.

Students will have to wear masks while on the school buses because it is a federal mandate.

Gretz said students will attend five days a week and much will return to how things were before the pandemic.

More than 40 people let their opinions be known with much whooping and hollering from the gallery when the speaker agreed with their point of view.

Superintendent Peter Gretz sat listening quietly to all who spoke, even bowing his head as Cat Campbell asked to lead the group in prayer.

"Lord Jesus, this is a challenging time. It's not about what is popular, but what is right. We ask for guidance and wisdom and to move forward in love and kindness," Campbell said.

On Wednesday morning, Gretz emailed a letter to parents and staff in which he encouraged residents going to the meeting to model, "The ability to engage in healthy conflict and navigate problems with people of different perspectives," calling it an "essential skill."

About five of the 40 speakers urged the board to consider changing policies to go along with legal mandates to not stigmatize transgender students.

After thanking Gretz for the letter, Cindy Girard said everyone wants their children to succeed.

"Our transgender students are not predators to be feared or an abomination," she said.

Jessica Jackson, a retired teacher, said critical race theory is "something Fox

news is using to divide us."

Karen Mann said she is a woman who presents as a man.

"In fact, several people called me sir when they greeted me here. But I have the emotional resources to deal with that," she said, while young people may not.

Mann urged the Board to make policies that accommodate transgender students.

More three quarters of those who spoke echoed each other in asking the board to not change policies for transgender students and to make mask-wearing voluntary.

After Campbell prayed, she said she personally emailed school staff asking one question: Should mask wearing be mandatory or voluntary for students and staff?

"I received 132 responses and 73 percent of those wanted masks to be voluntary," Campbell said.

The schools employ more than 500.

Jennifer Scopelliti said it's a "scientific fact" there are only two genders.

Many others stated a similar sentiment. Several echoed Danny Reed's promise to find an educational coop and pull their children from Fluvanna schools if transgender policies are changed.

Several spoke of their own children being sexually harassed at school.

Roger Bowles acknowledged Gretz. "Wow, thank you for listening Dr. Gretz. Welcome to the fire," Bowles said. "Give your parents and students choice about the mask. Don't worry about what comes from Richmond. We'll tell you what to do here in Fluvanna."

After public comments, Gretz spoke. "I think it's a great opportunity for you to see my true colors," he said.

Gretz explained how the Virginia School Board of Education guidelines on policies regarding transgender policies came to be.

The Virginia General Assembly passed a law in 2020 that stemmed from a Virginia

Supreme Court ruling in a case brought by a transgender student, Gavin Grimm.

Grimm transitioned from female to male while a student in Gloucester County High School. Grimm began using the boy's restroom. Parents complained, and the Gloucester County School Board passed a regulation requiring students to use the restroom that matched their biological gender. Grimm continued to face ridicule and his parents sued the school board on grounds of Title IX discrimination and the Equal Protection clause. After many rulings and appeals, in the end, the U.S. Supreme Court refused to hear an appeal to the ruling that found for both of Grimm's claims on Title IX and Equal Protection.

Because the Supreme Court refused to hear the appeal, the lower court's ruling stands.

The Virginia General Assembly mandated that, "The Department of Education shall develop and make available to each

school board model policies concerning the treatment of transgender student in public elementary and secondary schools that address common issues regarding transgender students in accordance with evidence-based best practices..."

Gretz said Fluvanna schools have a policy of offering a single stall restroom to transgender students, which follows the law.

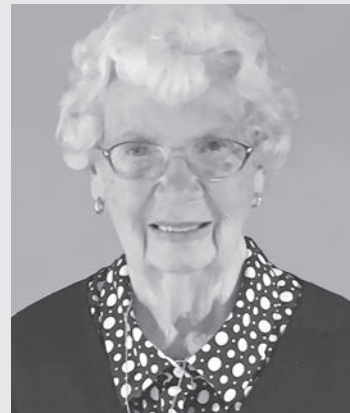
The problem would be if a transgender student said they still felt discriminated against and wanted to use the facilities that matched the gender they identify as.

"The problem would be denying a student's insistence on using the bathroom that conforms to their gender identity," Gretz said.

After much discussion, Gretz asked for one month to talk to school administrators, nurses and others so he can form a recommendation.

The Board granted that, tabling the discussion until the Aug. 11 meeting.

Sharon Nalle

**Project Lifesaver
Program keeping
people safe**

When Joyce McCollough's husband's illness left him with cognitive challenges, she joined the many caregivers whose loved ones' safety becomes a priority. When you are the only caregiver, you cannot turn your back for fear your charge may wander off somewhere. This fear creates a significant amount of anxiety for the caregivers.

But McCollough found a solution that gave her peace of mind, a program called Project Lifesaver, a personal locator system available throughout the U.S. McCollough is enrolled in the Fluvanna County Project Lifesaver program.

"I knew, because of my job, that there were GPS systems out there to monitor children with disabilities, so I started exploring systems for adults with dementia," said McCollough.

Their goal is to provide a quick response to save lives and reduce potential injury for adults and children who wander due to Alzheimer's, autism, and other related conditions or disorders. They have saved over 3,800 lives and the longest search was in California for an autistic child that took five hours and fifty-nine minutes. The shortest search was for a person with Alz-

heimer's in New Mexico and it took only three minutes. The average is 30 minutes or less or 95 percent less time than conventional searches.

Searching for wandering or lost individuals with Alzheimer's, autism, down syndrome, dementia, or other cognitive conditions is growing and without effective procedures and equipment, searches can involve multiple agencies, hundreds of officers, countless volunteers, and thousands of dollars. The most important feature of the system is reducing the time it takes to locate these people and avoiding the risk of something tragic happening to them.

Project Lifesaver was started in 1999 as a local entity in Chesapeake. It is a com-

munity-based, public safety non-profit organization, providing law enforcement, fire and rescue, and caregivers the first program of its kind using locating technology in search and rescue.

"The Project Lifesaver bands are easy to apply and keep up with. The system is a band and fob that can be put on the wrist or ankle. The battery needs to be changed once a month by someone from the Fluvanna County Sheriff's office. The fob is given a number that can be tracked through GPS," said McCollough. "Should the person wearing the fob become lost the sheriff's office has a device that can locate the fob eliminating manpower that would be needed to find a lost dementia patient. I have checked our destinations

over the last few years and all of the localities show they have this system available should he wonder away from me."

Structured with using state-of-the-art technology, community policing requires specific education courses, including innovative search and rescue methods not often used in traditional search and instructions on how to approach individuals with these conditions. Training requires certification and includes the use of the equipment and implementation of strategic methods designed exclusively for the program, including the use of the PLS Database which is a useful tool provided to member agencies at no cost.

There is a one-time cost for the transmitter and low-cost monthly fee which

is nothing compared to the peace of mind that caregivers receive in return knowing their loved one is safe.

"Project Lifesavers has given me peace of mind. In practical everyday life, it has meant that I, as the caregiver, can leave him alone to go to the bathroom in a store or shower at home without worrying because if he decides to take a walk I know that I have a backup way to find him."

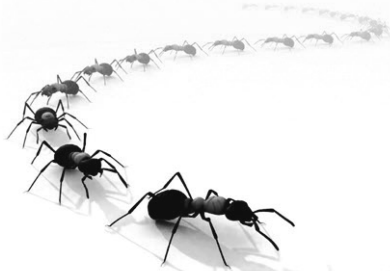

Pitts' Market on Main Street

In the 1950's, Scottsville had four grocery stores. One of these, opened in 1937, was across Main Street from the Methodist Church and run by W. R. (Robert) and Ruth Pitts. The previous owners were Edward and Betty Kent, Ruth's parents. The building was remodeled after it was sold in 1962 and now houses apartments (James River Apartments). There used to be two large plate glass windows on either side of the building's front door. Pat Pitts, whose parents ran the store, remembers, "My dad spent a great deal of time placing

items in the window for display to try and attract customers into the business."

As you walked into Pitts' Market, you went to the counter and asked for what you wanted -- no wandering up and down the aisles. The store carried all sorts of edibles, including canned goods, fresh fruits and vegetables, and meat. The store had a meat grinder, and sometimes after-hours Mr. Pitts would grind up some pork or other meat that a customer had slaughtered in order to make sausage. There was also an ice cream freezer with popsicles and Dixie cups. Few people had freezers at home, so ice cream was a special treat.

Most customers did not pay cash immediately but ran a tab. The grocer would write out their purchases and give them a carbon copy. At the end of the month, Mrs. Pitts would send out the bills, an early version of credit cards. There was some barter as well. A customer might bring in fresh produce from their garden and trade it for canned goods. You could

call for home delivery---no charge---and either Pat Pitts or his brother, Billy (children of W.R. and Ruth Pitts) would cheerfully bring your order to your door.

Mr. Pitts was Mayor of Scottsville from 1955 to 1959. He also ran a real estate business. When his wife began to suffer from cancer, they closed the store and sold the building. Pat thinks they just about broke even with the store---real estate was less time-consuming and more profitable.

The building had been a boarding house at one time. The Pitts family lived behind it in a spacious apartment with extra bedrooms upstairs. They did not regularly rent out rooms, but during World War II, Doris Glass Graves lived there while her husband served overseas. It was a question from Amanda Reeves, her granddaughter, that set off this topic. Thanks to Pat Pitts for being an excellent "historical source."

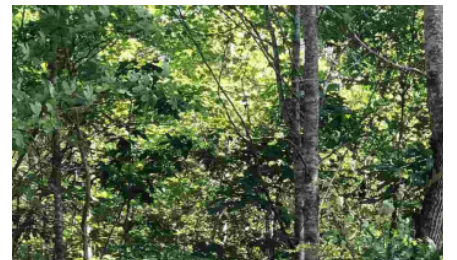

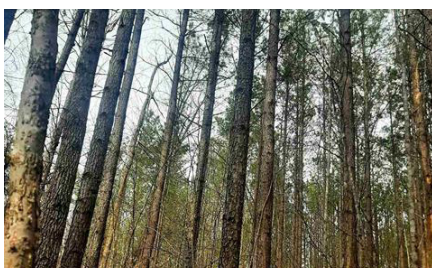
