

### Six districts cost taxpayers

On Nov. 17, three of the members of the Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors voted to expand the number of districts in Fluvanna County from five to six. Don Weaver (Cunningham), Trish Eager (Palmyra) and Mike Sheridan (Columbia) are in favor of increasing the cost and size of government.

The Board's legal counsel, Fred Payne, advised against increasing the size of government to minimize the possibility of a lawsuit. Weaver, Sheridan and Eager should listen to their lawyer. A lawsuit will cost us, the taxpayers.

The Commonwealth of Virginia is still working on the state's redistricting, which may force Fluvanna to redraw the new district lines. The BOS should delay any decision until after the state announces its redistricting plan. The work to redraw the

lines will cost us, the taxpayers.

Six districts will cost the taxpayers an estimated \$70,000 per year. Redistricting is for ten years. Do the math. This is a significant amount to us, the taxpayers.

Six districts will inevitably lead to tie votes on important county matters with no action being taken. When Fluvanna County had six districts in the past, delays in action came at a considerable cost to us, the taxpayers.

Staying with five districts is the best option for the taxpayers of Fluvanna County. There are no significant new or ongoing costs to the taxpayers. Potential legal challenges will be

# **Village Gardens fails to** win rezoning fight

A long-running drama came to an end at the Planning Commission on Tuesday night (Dec. 7), as commissioners voted 5-0 to deny a rezoning request for the controversial Village Gardens housing development.

This was the third time since Sept. 14 that the commission had devoted almost a full meeting to Village Gardens. Southern Development had managed to delay the final vote -- which from the beginning seemed likely to end in defeat -- with first a 90-day deferral, then a 30-day delay.

In a dramatic twist, Tuesday's hearing opened with the news that Southern Development was no longer in charge of the project.

Jeremy Swink of Stanley Martin Homes told the commission that they were "partnering" with Southern Development on Village Gardens -- although the term "partnership" seemed somewhat loose.

"We've reached an agreement to purchase the property, and not only develop, but also build the homes," said Swink.

He said Stanley Martin Homes had been watching the project since it was proposed earlier this year and had been actively involved for about a month and a half.

Swink highlighted a number of changes his team had made in the effort to "make a better project than what was initially put forth," he said.

The new plan called for 325 homes, a 10 percent reduction from the original concept. At least 35 percent of units would be single-level and geared towards older, "move-down" buyers who presumably wouldn't contribute children to the county school system.

Buffers between Village Gardens and surrounding properties were made wider. Streets were made wider, and more parking areas were added.

An access point between Village Gardens and Lake Monticello was removed, and the end of Garden Lane was turned into a cul-de-sac.

With residents at the Villages at Nahor concerned new residents might detour through their neighborhood, Swink unveiled a new entrance design that would block any attempt to take that kind of shortcut.

A 9.000-square foot retail space envisioned in the original plan was largely deleted, although three acres would be available for commercial sale.

And then came what was meant to be the real sweetener.

Swink said their analysis of VDOT's recent traffic studies showed that there had been 18 accidents around Lake Monticello's nearby Monish Gate. Cars turning left into the gate are a well-known cause of traffic back-ups on Rt. 53 during peak hours.

His company was in the process of finalizing the purchase of 1.3 acres of land across from the gate and planned to invest \$1.6 million dollars to work with VDOT in the construction of a left-turn lane into Monish and other improvements on that stretch of 53.

"My approach was that maybe I would have more impact by making significant off-site improvements versus removing trips because I think the magnitude of what we're proposing offsite far exceeds the impact

of removing maybe 50 homes," Swink said.

But none of these changes assuaged the concerns of the commissioners over traffic impacts, stormwater management, and water infrastructure.

Public pressure against the project, particularly from Lake Monticello residents, has been intense. At one point, a commissioner asked that the audience be polled to see if there was anyone there in support of Village Gardens. No hands were raised. Public comments lasted for well over an hour.

At one point, Chair Barry Bibb asked Swink if he could come up with any "positive benefits" to the community from the project. Swink cited his commitment to investing in improvements at Monish Gate and the general idea that "people become friends with neighbors."

"I don't think the property is ready," said Commissioner Gequetta Murray-Key. "We have been giving and giving the opportunity to present the information that we're looking for to make an informed decision."

Murray-Key made the motion to deny the rezoning request, which passed by a vote of 5-0.









# Holiday gift from school board rose by .0087 percent, which means about a \$600,000

At its meeting Wednesday (Dec. 8) the Fluvanna County School Board voted to give staff and students an early Christmas gift: three days off.

Superintendent Peter Gretz said Dec. 20, 21 and 22 were scheduled as school days, but he suggested adding them to the holiday vacation.

Gretz said giving that time off to students and 10month contract staff could be in recognition of how difficult the school year has been.

Discussing the proposal, Andrew Pullen (Columbia) said he'd like to extend it to all staff.

Board Chair Perrie Johnson (Fork Union) said staff and teachers hired under a 10-month contract don't get nearly the amount of paid holidays as year-round

"But haven't 12-month employees had a difficult year?" said James Kelley (Palmyra).

Pullen said, "I agree with Dr. Kelley."

Acknowledging the rare moment of consensus, Pullen said, "Capture this moment."

The Board voted unanimously to grant all staff those three extra paid days off. Students will return from break on Jan. 5.

Charles Rittenhouse (Cunningham) did not attend

During his superintendent's report, Gretz said more students are attending the new, after-school tutoring and remediation sessions.

Attendance is hovering around 90 percent, he said.

There is a small group of students at each grade level who are not engaging in education: either online or in-person, Gretz said. Each student's reasons are different and multi-faceted.

Gretz said administrators, teachers and staff are working together to find the best solution(s).

In other business:

An eight-hour, hunter-safety course will be offered to students Feb. 26.

Gretz said the number of COVID-19 cases is going down in the schools. He said very few of those who go into quarantine because of contact with a COVID-. 19 positive person actually contract the virus.



# Fluco boys' basketball off to a strong start

The Fluco boy's basketball team has won its first three games, all against non-Jefferson District opponents. The team, under Coach Heath Bralley opened its regular season on the road on Dec.1, traveling to Waynesboro High. The Flucos took a 27-17 lead at half time and won by nine, 54-45. On Dec. 3, the boys played their home opener against Chancellor High. The Flucos put up 45 points in the second half to post a 67-53 win. On Dec. 7, the Flucos traveled to Chancellor High. In the rematch, the result was very much the same, as the Flucos posted a 61-47 win.

Before the season began, Coach Bralley predicted that his team would rely heavily on its guards for scoring. So far that prediction has come true. Against Waynesboro, senior guard Kobe Edmonds led the way in scoring with 16, including two threepoint shots. He also had four assists. Second in scoring was guard Bobby Gardner who contribute 13 points. Forward Kenyon Smith had eight points and 12 rebounds. Overall, the Flucos did not shoot well in the game, but they forced a remarkably high 30 turnovers.

In their first game against Chancellor High, Edmonds again led the team in scoring, with Gardner close behind. Edmonds scored 27 on a very good 10 of 18 from the field including four of six from three-point range. Gardner put up 22 points, and also had seven offensive rebounds. Smith also got into double figures with 11. The Fluco defense was strong again as it forced 23 turnovers

In the third game of the season, a third Fluco guard jumped into the picture. Lance Bruce came through with 17 points, making all six of his shots, including two three pointers, he also had three of four from the foul line. The high scorer for the Flucos was Edmonds for the third time with 20 points. He shot eight of 15 from the field and recorded three steals. Gardner contributed 13 points, seven rebounds and four steals. The Flucos again led in the turnover category, forcing 19.

The Flucos hosted Charlottesville High on Dec. 14 and played Waynesboro for a second time on Dec. 15. On Dec. 17, they play at Goochland and on Dec. 18 they take a long road trip to play at Lord Botetourt. On Dec. 22, they host Spotswood High. After that, they do not return to action until Jan. 4 when they will host Monticello High as Jefferson District play gets seriously underway.


