

Lake Monticello Board to aggressively seek unpaid dues

Inflation is the lead story on many news stations this week and it was no different at the Saturday (July 30) Lake Monticello Owners' Association Board of Directors' meeting.

In his report to the Board, LMOA General Manager Tom Schauder shared a list of ongoing initiatives, including one to "identify revenue sources to offset inflation, rising costs of doing business."

While there were some ideas mentioned to increase revenue—even by Laker Devan Walding, who told the Board he and his friends would like to see the campground opened and some RV storage on the mostly-unused land—collecting money already owed to the association received the most attention.

LMOA Finance Director Mike Warner reported that LMOA is going to go after unpaid dues more aggressively. He said that while "98 percent pay dues on time," LMOA has recently written off some \$733,000 in bad debt. He said LMOA has now turned over about \$300,000 in uncollected dues to Chadwick Washington, a law firm that specializes in HOA collections.

That law firm will begin sending letters to delinquent homeowners, who will then have 40 days to respond, Warner explained in his report to the Board, adding that next steps will include garnishing bank accounts and paychecks. He said LMOA has not previously so aggressively gone after unpaid dues. "We do intend to get this cleared up and we do intend to get people to pay," Warner said.

"We will be pursuing judgments, liens, garnishments and foreclosures to encourage prompt payments by the two percent of our members who do not pay their obligations," Warner said. LMOA has historically offered payment plans to those who initiate them with the LMOA office.

Warner also reported that pool labor (lifeguard pay) is more than double what the association paid two years ago and while "labor costs are up," revenue is down "across the board."

"Labor is up 21 percent and costs are up 30 to 40 percent," Indigo Golf Partners' (IGP) Carl Lasley told the LMOA Board, referring to golf and food and beverage operations. He said that while 2021 was a record year "in a positive way" with \$209,000 in losses for food and beverage (F&B) and golf, this year he forecasts that deficit to be \$400,000.

Before IGP took over F & B, the combined losses with golf topped \$650,000, LMOA Treasurer Jay Hinkel reminded his fellow board members. He said that while revenue is up in golf and F & B this year, expenses are up too.

Lasley said increased outside golf play (from non-Lake residents) is helping offset the lower total number of golf rounds

played. He said Indigo plans to "break down that wall of exclusivity" to help generate even more outside rounds.

Earlier this year, Lasley said The Pub faced hiring challenges, but a "more attractive compensation package" has helped with staffing. He said his team is trying various methods of increasing revenue, while holding down costs. Those changes include making "slight adjustments to our menu," opening up Ashlawn for food service to "open up a new revenue stream," and looking at a different model for operating the pool next year.

Starting Labor Day Weekend, Lakeside Restaurant at the Ashlawn Clubhouse will be open every weekend Friday through Sunday, Lasley reported last night, calling the move "exciting."

"This is the move to make for the longterm health of F & B," Lasley said, adding that he knew when he first arrived at Lake Monticello that this would be the way forward.

In other money business, the Board approved a Budget Calendar, scheduling 2023 Budget Work Sessions for Nov. 5 and Nov. 10. These sessions are open to all LMOA members. There will also be two open Finance Committee budget planning sessions. "There are four opportunities (for members) to see the proposed budget," Hinkel said.

The Board also approved the purchase of a gazebo for a "Golfers' Lounge" for \$3,000 to be taken from PTF (Property Transfer Fee money). The Board also approved some \$28,000 (also from PTF) to buy and remove a foreclosed, abandoned house at 839 Jefferson Drive. LMOA plans to clear the property and resell it to recoup the money spent.









A new program takes and distributes medical equipment

The Cunningham United Methodist Church is partnering with All Blessings Flow for a new community outreach program. Medical equipment is expensive and many people who have gently used medical equipment in good condition wonder where they can donate it. This program brings together those who want to donate and those in need.

All Blessings Flow (ABF) is a local faithbased non-profit founded to improve the quality of life of families living with disabilities and serious health conditions. ABF's mission is to provide medical equipment and supplies to those in need and has a mobile unit that helps to pick up and distribute the much-needed items. They serve those in need in Charlottesville, Albemarle, and surrounding counties. Medical equipment, even for a short-term recovery can be costly and ABF helps to reduce those costs, particularly when a family is struggling to care for a loved one.

They take the gently used medical equipment that many people no longer need or want and redistribute it to those who can benefit. Hence all blessings flow comes from "something that once blessed you or your loved one and can now become a blessing for someone else. One blessing becomes another and - all blessings flow."

Volunteers are always needed for various jobs. John Mann drives the mobile unit and he and others get equipment from a warehouse in Charlottesville. Both he and his wife Kitti are members and volunteers with Cunningham United Methodist Church. He fills one volunteer job but there are many others, including repairing medical equipment such as wheelchairs, rolling walkers, etc., assisting in cleaning equipment, doing inventory, helping clients with requests for medical equipment and supplies, receiving donations, and stocking shelves. They also need strong volunteers to help pick up and deliver larger items such as hospital beds.



With the start of the school year fast approaching, Fluvanna County Public Schools welcomed their new teaching staff at an orientation breakfast on Monday morning (Aug. 1).

Amanda Galloway talked about their role in working with juvenile cases.


"We're here to help these kids get back on track," said Haislip. "We're here to help the kids, and we're here to help you."

Sheriff Eric Hess explained that they had three school resource officers (SROs) on staff in the schools and had applied for funding for an additional two positions.


The event was informal and good-natured, concluding with Student Activities Coordinator Scott Morris tossing out t-shirts during a quick game of "Fluco

MEDIA RELEASE 2022-2023 POLICY FOR PROVIDING FREE OR REDUCED PRICE MEALS

Date: July 1, 2022

Fluvanna County Public Schools today announced its policy for providing free or reduced-price meals for children served under the National School Lunch, and/or School Breakfast Programs. Each school and/or central school nutrition office has a copy of the policy, which may be reviewed by any interested party.

Household size and income will be used to determine eligibility for free or reduced-price meal benefits. Children from households whose income is at or below the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines, shown in the chart below, may be eligible for either free or reduced-price meals. Children who are members of households receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits (formerly the Food Stamp Program) or who receive Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) may be automatically eligible for free meals. Children who are homeless, migrant, or runaway may also be automatically eligible for free meals. Foster children, who are the legal responsibility of a welfare agency or court, are eligible for free meals regardless of the income of the household with whom they reside. Children who are members of households participating in WIC may also be eligible for free or reduced-price meals based on the household's income.

Application forms are being distributed to all households with a letter informing households of the availability of free or reduced-price meals for their children. Applications are also available at the principal's office in each school and at the central office. To apply for free or reduced-price meals, households must only fill out one application per household and return it to the school division. Applications may be submitted at any time during the school year. The information households provide on the application will be used for determining eligibility and verification of data. Applications may be verified at any time during the school year by school or other program officials. For school officials to determine eligibility for free or reduced-price benefits, households receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) only have to list their child(ren)'s name and SNAP or TANF case number and an adult household member must sign the application. Households who do not list a SNAP or TANF case number, including WIC households, must list the names of all household members, the amount and frequency of the income received by each household member, and the last four digits of the social security number of the adult household member who signs the application. If the household member does not have a social security number, the household member must indicate that a social security number is not available. The application must be signed by an adult household member in order to be approved.

Under the provisions of the free and reduced price meal policy, Gwendolyn Jones will review applications and determine eligibility. An application for free or reduced-price meals cannot be approved unless it is complete. Households dissatisfied with the ruling of the eligibility determining official may wish to discuss the decision with the official on an informal basis. Households may apply for free or reduced-price meals at any time during the school year. If a household is not eligible now but has a change, such as a decrease in household income, an increase in household size, becomes unemployed or qualifies for SNAP or TANF, the household should contact the school for an application. Such changes may make the children of the household eligible for benefits if the household's income falls at or below the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines.

Households that receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits (formerly the Food Stamp Program) or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) may not have to complete an application for free or reduced-price student meals. School officials will determine eligibility for free meals based on documentation, obtained directly from the Virginia Department of Social Services, that a child is a member of a household currently receiving SNAP or TANF. School officials will notify these households in writing of their eligibility. Households who are notified of their eligibility, but who do not want their children to receive free meals, must contact the school. SNAP and TANF households must complete an application if they are not notified in writing of their automatic eligibility within the first 10 days of the new school year

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their children's education records. These rights transfer to the student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends a school beyond the high school level. Students to whom the rights have transferred are "eligible students."

- Parents or eligible students have the right to inspect and review the student's education records maintained by the school. Schools are not required to provide copies of records unless, for reasons such as great distance, it is impossible for parents or eligible students to review the records. Schools may charge a fee for copies.
- Parents or eligible students have the right to request that a school correct records which they believe to be inaccurate or misleading. If the school decides not to amend the record, the parent or eligible student then has the right to a formal hearing. After the hearing, if the school still decides not to amend the record, the parent or eligible student has the right to place a statement with the record setting forth his or her view about the contested information.
- Generally, schools must have written permission from the parent or eligible student in order to release any information from a student's education record. However, FERPA allows schools to disclose those records, without consent, to the following parties or under the following conditions (34 CFR § 99.31):
 - School officials with legitimate educational interest;
 - Other schools to which a student is transferring;
 - Specified officials for audit or evaluation purposes;
 - Appropriate parties in connection with financial aid to a student;
 - Organizations conducting certain studies for or on behalf of the school;
 - Accrediting organizations;
 - To comply with a judicial order or lawfully issued subpoena;
 - Appropriate officials in cases of health and safety emergencies; and
 - State and local authorities, within a juvenile justice system, pursuant to specific State law.

Schools may disclose, without consent, "directory" information such as a student's name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, honors and awards, and dates of attendance. However, schools must tell parents and eligible students about directory information and allow parents and eligible students a reasonable amount of time to request that the school not disclose directory information about them. Schools must notify parents and eligible students annually of their rights under FER-PA. The actual means of notification (special letter, inclusion in a PTA bulletin, student handbook, or newspaper article) is left to the discretion of each school.

The Fluvanna County Public Schools are committed to providing all children with opportunities to benefit from public education. Child Find is the process of identifying children with potential special education needs and educating the community about child development and the importance of early intervention.

Students are identified and placed in special education programs in accordance with the Virginia Board of Education's Regulations Governing Special Education Programs for Children with Disabilities in Virginia. These guidelines, as well as the comprehensive Standards of Quality and the Objectives for Public Schools in Virginia, provide the organizational framework for all education programs and related services.

Each student, ages 2 through 21 inclusive, receiving special education services has a program designed to meet his or her individual needs. These programs are discussed and planned by school personnel, parents, and the student involved. Often, instructional programming is carried out in both regular and special education classrooms. The student's progress is reviewed at least yearly and his or her need for special education services is reassessed at a minimum of every three years. Disabling conditions include the following: autism; deaf-blindness; visual impairment; developmental delay; emotional disability; hearing impairment/deaf; intellectual disability; specific learning disability; multiple disabilities; orthopedic impairment; other health impairment; speech or language impairment; and traumatic brain injury.

If you suspect that your child has a disability, please contact the principal of the school that your child attends or would attend if he/she were enrolled in public school. Homeowners asked to report destructive jumping worms

While many gardeners welcome worms in their soil, there's one wriggling fiend that is unwanted.

Virginia Cooperative Extension is asking Virginia residents to keep an eye out for the invasive jumping worm. Recently spotted in Chesterfield County, the worms are becoming widespread across the state. Since 2019, they've been seen in Albemarle, Bedford, Chesterfield, Frederick, Goochland, Loudoun, Louisa, Montgomery, Northumberland, Prince William and Wise counties, as well as in the cities of Fairfax, Lynchburg and Virginia Beach, according to the Virginia Tech Department of Entomology.

"Mainly we hope that people are aware of these invasive worms and try their best to not spread them through potted plants or soil," said Theresa Dellinger, Virginia Tech insect identification lab diagnostician.

Also known as Alabama jumpers, crazy worms, Jersey wrigglers and snake worms, they're recognized by their erratic jumping and thrashing behavior when handled or disturbed.

Ranging from red to brownish purple in color, they're identifiable by a smooth, milky-colored band of tissue that encircles the worm's body. Measuring 3 to 6 inches long, they sometimes have a

glossy, iridescent sheen but are not slimy to the touch.

While many worms are thought to be beneficial to the soil, the jumping worm is an exception. They feed on leaf litter and mulch at the soil's surface, removing an important organic layer and changing the soil structure underneath—leaving it bare, with a uniformly dry, granular appearance resembling coffee grounds.

This leaf litter consumption also removes beneficial nutrients that plants need and changes the moisture level of the underlying soil—increasing the potential for erosion. Additionally, animals that live and feed on the leaf litter and topsoil may be affected by habitat loss.

Extension cautions people to be aware when sharing plants that may contain jumping worms, and avoid introducing organic mulch or soil from outside sources unless it's been heat-treated. Thoroughly clean items with soil on them, such as gardening tools and shoes, before going into another yard.

Additionally, worms sold as bait should never be released in the wild.

"It's almost certain that some of these worms have been spread by people using them for fish bait too," Dellinger noted. "And people buying worms online for composting should be aware that their

purchase may actually contain a mix of worms, including jumping worms."




