



NOTICE OF FY 2025 BUDGET, PROPOSED TAX RATES AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN PUBLIC HEARING FLUVANNA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Pursuant to Virginia Code Sec. 15.2-2506 a public hearing on the proposed FY 2025 County of Fluvanna budget and Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) will be held on Wednesday, April 10, 2024, beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the Carysbrook Performing Arts Center, 8880 James Madison Hwy, Fork Union, Virginia, at which time citizens of the County will be given an opportunity to appear before, and be heard by the Board of Supervisors on the subject of the FY 2025 Budget and FY 2026-2029 CIP.

The budget totals \$109,232,910 in revenues and expenditures, which represents a 4.84% increase from FY 2024. The proposed budget includes the following tax rates that
