

NOTICE OF PROPOSED REAL PROPERTY TAX RATE INCREASE FLUVANNA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Per Virginia Code Section 58.1-3321, notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of Fluvanna County proposes to increase property tax levies.

- (1) Assessment Increase: Total assessed value of real property, excluding additional assessments due to new construction or improvements to property, exceeds last year's total assessed value of real property by 22.55 percent.
- (2) Lowered Rate Necessary to Offset Increased Assessment: The tax rate which would levy the same amount of real estate tax as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of real estate with the exclusions mentioned above would be \$0.689 per \$100 of assessed value. This rate will be known as the "lowered tax rate."
- (3) Effective Rate Increase: The County of Fluvanna proposes to adopt a maximum tax rate of \$0.750 per \$100 of assessed value. The difference between the lowered tax rate and the proposed rate would be \$0.061 per \$100 or 8.85 percent. This difference will be known as the "effective tax rate increase".
 - Individual property taxes may, however, increase at a percentage greater than or less than the above percentage.
- (4) Proposed Total Budget Increase: Based on the proposed real property tax rate and changes in other revenues, the total budget of Fluvanna County will exceed last year's by 8.78 percent ¹.

A public hearing on the proposed tax rate and increase above will be held on Wednesday, April 09, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. at the County Administration Building in the Morris Room, 132 Main Street, Palmyra, Virginia 22963.
