

NOTICE OF FY 2026 BUDGET, PROPOSED TAX RATES AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN PUBLIC HEARING

FLUVANNA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Pursuant to Virginia Code Sec. 15.2-2506 a public hearing on the proposed FY 2026 County of Fluvanna budget and Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) will be held on Wednesday, April 16, 2025, beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the Circuit Court Room, 72 Main St., Palmyra, Virginia, at which time citizens of the County will be given an opportunity to appear before, and be heard by the Board of Supervisors on the subject of the FY 2026 Budget and FY 2027-2030 CIP.

The budget totals \$117,769,609 in revenues and expenditures, which represents a 9.55% increase from FY 2025. The proposed budget includes the following tax rates that would be effective for the tax year 2025.

All levies above are per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.
