Long-running lawsuit over Fluvanna prison medical care ends

A federal class-action lawsuit over medical care at Fluvanna Correctional Center for Women has ended after 14 years, closing one of the longest-running challenges to conditions at the Troy prison.

Scott v. Clarke, filed in 2012 by women incarcerated at the facility, alleged that the Virginia Department of Corrections (VDOC), prison officials, and a private medical provider failed to provide adequate medical care, a violation of the Eighth Amendment's prohibition against cruel and unusual punishment.

The lawsuit led to a 2016 settlement agreement and nearly a decade of court-ordered monitoring by an independent medical monitor.

Under the agreement, the prison was required to follow generally accepted national clinical guidelines for treating chronic illnesses and other medical conditions. The settlement also set standards for staffing and response times for nonemergency and urgent care requests.

Legal Aid Justice Center (LAJC), one of the organizations representing the plaintiffs, said the lawsuit led to several lasting changes, including the adoption of electronic medical records at Fluvanna and other VADOC facilities, improvements to medication-assisted treatment for substance use, better dental care, and improvements in mental health care.

Dr. Homer Venters, former chief medical officer for the New York City jail system, served as the court-appointed federal monitor overseeing health care reforms at Fluvanna Correctional Center for Women.

The case was dismissed after Venters found that the prison had met the medical goals and standards in the settlement and maintained full compliance for one year.

"I'm sorry that it's coming to a close," said plaintiff Toni Hart-

love. "Dr. Venters cares about the welfare of the people here."

Advocates stressed that the end of court supervision does not mean all concerns have been resolved.

"Regardless of if the lawsuit has ended, I'm still advocating for the ladies here. A lot of us are afraid that the care will go downhill from now. I hope and pray that doesn't happen. If something falls through the cracks, that could be their life," Cynthia Scott, a named plaintiff in the case, said in a statement.

LAJC said problems remain in the prison infirmary, where isolation is a serious concern, and in the handling of chronic care, where regular coordination is needed to prevent serious complications or death.

Supervisors approve new advanced EMT position

The Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors approved a new advanced EMT position within the Department of Emergency Services during its June 3 meeting, creating a midlevel classification between basic EMTs and medics.

County Administrator Eric Dahl said the change reflects the additional training and certifications required of emergency medical providers to deliver a higher level of patient care.

Under the revised structure, basic EMTs, advanced EMTs, and medics will each have separate job descriptions that reflect their different levels of certification and responsibilities. The former advanced life support EMT position will be renamed "medic," covering intermediate and paramedic providers.

Director of Emergency Services M.J. Fick said basic EMT training generally requires about 190 hours, plus clinical rotations, while advanced EMT training requires an additional 220 hours or more. A person must already be certified as an EMT before entering advanced EMT training.

"As it stands right now, those EMTs and AEMTs are in the same position," Fick said. "They're

being paid the same amount.”

Fick said the advanced EMT level carries a much broader scope of practice than the basic EMT level. Advanced EMTs can administer more medications, start IVs, and perform additional emergency procedures. He said advanced EMTs can now administer epinephrine during cardiac arrest and fentanyl for pain management, both of which are outside the scope of a basic EMT.

“An AEMT can do more things in the back of an ambulance for the patient than an EMT can,” Fick said. “I think that it’s rightfully so that they’re compensated a little bit better.”

The projected annual salary and benefit increase is about \$27,000. Supervisors approved a fiscal year 2027 budget transfer of \$16,500 from emergency services operational budget lines to personnel lines, along with a \$10,511 transfer from personnel contingency.

Supervisor Tim Hodge, who made the motion, said simply, “Thank you for taking care of your people.”

The motion passed unanimously.

VDOT

Supervisors also heard from Craig Simpson, VDOT’s new Louisa residency engineer, shortly after a resident used public comment to complain about mowing along Nahor Manor Road.

James von Ottenritter said VDOT crews had used his property and nearby properties for training, mowed beyond the roadside ditch and damaged private land, including an area he described as turtle habitat. He said crews had also mowed part of a neighbor’s property, creating access lanes that later became dumping areas.

“Stay off of private property,” von Ottenritter told supervisors, asking them to reach out to VDOT before mowing begins again.

Before Simpson began his quarterly update, supervisors asked him to look into the complaint and clarify how far VDOT’s right of way extends along

smaller rural roads. Simpson said rights-of-way are typically about 50 feet, though they can vary by location, and that he would need to look into the specific situation on Nahor Manor Road.

Simpson’s broader VDOT update included 225 pothole repairs, 62,000 linear feet of ditching, five miles of shoulder repair, three miles of roadway grading and 89 bags of litter removed during the quarter.

Supervisors also raised concerns about litter along Route 250, particularly from unsecured loads headed to the convenience center; deteriorating pavement along Route 600; and crash reporting near sharp curves, where vehicles may leave the road, but cause too little damage to appear in state crash data.

Other Business

In other business, supervisors authorized county staff to advertise a July 1 public hearing on a proposed amendment to the county’s agreement with the Fluvanna County Radio Control Flying Club, which uses county-owned land near the former landfill on West River Road. The club has asked to replace its existing geotextile landing strip with asphalt at its own expense and extend its agreement with the county from five years to 10 years. Staff said the change would not affect operations at the convenience center.

Dahl also told supervisors that the James River Water Authority may have an opportunity to refund or refinance debt through the Virginia Resources Authority. Early estimates suggest potential savings of about \$200,000 to \$281,000 over the life of the bonds, shared between Fluvanna and Louisa counties.

Later, the board also approved a \$63,629.71 performance incentive grant payment connected to the Coves at Monticello workforce housing development. Dahl said the payment is part of a previously approved development performance agreement and is based on the property’s increased assessed value after construction.

Summer Is the Perfect Time for These Tax-Saving Movess

With the school year ended and summer about to heat up, there are plenty of opportunities to cut your 2026 tax bill. We will have two articles related to Tax Tips you can make this summer. This is the first of the two articles. The second will run on June 25th. Here are several ideas that could pay HUGE dividends moving forward.

- **Use the Augusta Rule.** If you rent out your main home or a vacation home part of the time, you may be entitled to deductions like other landlords. This includes the rental-related portion of mortgage interest, property taxes, repairs, utilities, insurance, etc. Keep in mind, if your personal use exceeds certain limits, you can’t deduct a loss. And if you rent for less than 14 days, the rental income is tax free!
- **Seasonal side hustle deductions.** If you take on summer work like tutoring, landscaping, or freelancing, you are considered self-employed and can claim certain deductions such as business mileage, equipment (like mowers or computers), supplies, and a portion of your phone/internet bill.

- **Send young kids to camp.** Depending on your situation, you may be able to claim a Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit for the cost of sending children under age 13 to summer day camp. However, the cost of overnight camp doesn’t qualify for the credit.

this summer, hire them to work for your business. Reasonable wages are deductible by the business and your child will likely owe little tax, if any, on the earnings. Plus, they may be eligible for other employee benefits.

When you travel for business, you can generally deduct expenses – including airfare, lodging and meals – attributable to the business portion of the trip. But you must spend more time on business matters while you’re away than you do on sightseeing or other personal activities. Spousal travel is not deductible, but there can still be savings on things like a hotel room.
- **Create a tax forecast.** Finally, create a tax projection well before year-end. Use this information to determine if the steps you’re taking now will help you avoid a large tax bill at the end of the year.

Lake Monticello Member-Guest Golf Tournament returns

After a break in 2025, the Lake Monticello Golf Course Member-Guest Golf Tournament returned in 2026.

This year's tournament drew 30 men's two-player teams and six women's two-player teams. The men's division played 27 holes on Saturday and 18 on Sunday, while

the women's division played 18 holes on Sunday.

The format for the men's tournament is challenging, as every hole matters. It is a match-play event, with teams divided into five-team 'flights.' Each team plays every other team in its flight once. On each hole, one point is awarded to the team with the lowest net score, with handicaps considered. A bonus point is awarded to the team with the best score over nine holes, giving each match a total of 10 points.

The women's tournament was

a straight best-ball tournament, with handicaps considered. The winning team was Robin Wink and Susan Genert, who shot an impressive 32-32—64. The runners-up were Judy Kordella and Joanne Platz, who posted a 69.

In the men's tournament, the highest-scoring team in each flight advanced to a shootout to determine the overall tournament winner.

The flight winners were Paul Schmidt and his guest, Andrew Schmidt, in the Amen Corner flight; Chris Gilbert and his guest, Robert Brooks, in the Green Jacket flight; Scott Fitzgerald and his guest, Adam Travis, in the Magnolia Lane flight; Richard Baringer and his guest, Devin Audibert, in the Butler Cabin flight; and Russell Denell and his guest, Steve Ruis, in the Golden Bell flight.

In the shootout, all teams played the first round from the 18th-hole tee box. Only two teams scored net birdies, eliminating the other three teams.

The second playoff round was played on the 18th hole from 135 yards out. A short iron shot is all

that is required, but the shot must cross a small pond.

Gilbert went first and hit an excellent shot to approximately 10 feet, hole high. His teammate, Brooks, also hit the green, but his shot finished about 35 feet long. Brooks putted ahead of Gilbert and rolled in the long putt. Their opponents could not do better than a three, so the shootout was over.

Gilbert and Brooks were the winners. Brooks, Gilbert's guest, was a high school friend who came in from Lynchburg. Gilbert has lived at the Lake for about five years.

and Stories.” Members will create iconic and historical works representing the last 250 years, using paint, mixed media, fiber art, sculpture, wood, glass, collage, and other media.

“This theme invites artists to explore the layered and evolving

identity of America through personal narrative, cultural memory, and collective experience. It is an opportunity to reflect on heritage, community, patriotism, pride, protest, and progress,” said FAA President Carol Sorber.

She said the artists’ work will cel-

brate many facets of the American experience, including traditions, ideals, untold histories, and moments that define the nation’s story.

“We encouraged interpretation that is bold or quiet, literal or abstract, celebratory or critical. We want the work to tell the artist’s story, someone else’s story, or one that hasn’t been heard,” Sorber said. “‘We the People’ is not just a phrase, but a conversation.”

Some of the artists have already explored the theme through self-expression and the diversity of perspectives that will be represented in the upcoming exhibit. The exhibit is not just about looking, but thinking.

Artist Mary Volin’s thought-provoking image of multi-colored hands holding up sparklers is a celebration of diversity. Another

artist chose collage, with Washington’s silhouette covered with historic American icons representing culture, innovation, war, civil rights, events, and people, set against a background of landmark documents. Lisa Daniel chose to paint Thomas Jefferson, the author of the Declaration of Independence, and Deborah Nixon used words as her visual self-expression.

The exhibit opens at the Fluvanna Public Library June 16 and runs through Aug. 17. A reception will be held June 20, from 12:30 to 2 p.m., featuring a special summer treat: an ice cream bar with cookies.

Commemorating history is compelling when the ideas are generated by local artists, and FAA members hope the exhibit will spark conversations among viewers about their own thoughts, memories, and experiences.

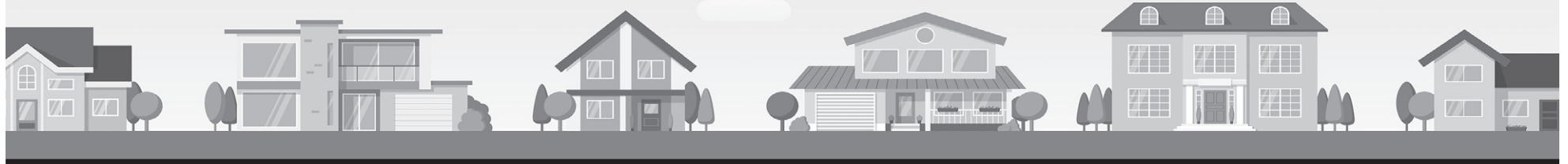


